

2013 Menands Ski/Snowboard Program Registration Packet



Quick Facts

- Program is open to all village residents.
- 7 Nights of Ski/Snowboarding every Tuesday starting January 8th 2013.
- 6 Lessons included on the first 6 trips. No lesson on the 7th trip.
- Bus departs Menands School at 3:30pm, and returns @ approximately 9:30pm.
- Children are to complete homework on the bus to the mountain.
- Children below grade 4 **must** be accompanied by an adult.
- Skiers/boarders will not be allowed to ski/board without a partner (for older children) and/or a chaperone.
- **Helmets are MANDATORY for all skiers and snowboarders.**

Cost for the program is \$155. If renting, the cost is \$251 for skiers or snowboarders.
(Please make all checks out to Jiminy Peak)

-The Coyote Ridge Freestyle Terrain Pass is an additional \$3 and must be purchased at the mountain.
-Adults only, 18 years or older, who do not want lessons can subtract \$5.

I acknowledge to JIMINY PEAK MOUNTAIN RESORT, LLC ("Resort") and understand (a) the dangers and risks of skiing, snowboarding, snow tubing, snowshoeing and other winter sports, (b) that ski/snowboard racing, jumping or freestyle competition is even more dangerous and risky, and (c) that I ASSUME ALL INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS of those sports at the Resort as provided by applicable state statute (NHRSA Ch. 225-A et seq., 12 VSA 1037 or MGL Ch. 143 § 71O). I agree that having a Resort employee present does not lessen the amount or severity of the risks or hazards of these activities. I accept the responsibility of maintaining control at all times while skiing, snowboarding, snow tubing, or snowshoeing.
2. I further understand and agree that in signing this Release, I am expressly ACKNOWLEDGING AND ASSUMING ADDITIONAL RISKS AND DANGERS that may result in property damage, PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH above and beyond those outlined in the applicable state statute, including but not limited to: equipment failure; equipment malfunction; equipment damage; my improper use of equipment; my use of my own personal equipment; my failure to maintain or otherwise upkeep my own personal equipment; slick or uneven surfaces; slipping; tripping; loss of balance; terrain parks; moguls; rugged mountainous terrain; bumps; tree wells; stumps; downed timber; rocks of various sizes; holes; debris; marked and unmarked obstacles; drainage channels; varying visibility; unmaintained trails; path and/or trail obstructions; unmarked roads and/or trails; avalanches; suffocation; I or another acting in a negligent manner that may cause and/or contribute to injury to me or others, such as selecting terrain that exceeds my ability and not acting within such ability; my failure to comply with signage; collisions with natural or man-made objects, including but not limited to lift towers and components thereof and other ski area components including lights, fences, posts, signs, pole lines and snowmaking equipment; collisions with other people; falling objects; encounters with snowmobiles and/or other motor vehicles; becoming lost or separated; lack of shelter; lift loading, unloading, and riding; storms, lightning, hail, snow and other adverse weather; limited access to and/or delay of medical attention; my health condition; strenuous activity; fatigue; exhaustion; dehydration; hypothermia; frostbite; mental distress from exposure to any of the above; and those that can reasonably be inferred therefrom and I further agree that they are both obvious and necessary of sport.
3. In consideration of the Resort's permission for me to participate in the aforementioned winter sports at the Resort, I hereby agree:
(a) not to bring a claim against or sue, and AGREE TO RELEASE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE the Resort, its employees, parent companies, owners, affiliates, vendors, agents, landowners, officers, directors, and their successors in interest, any equipment manufacturers and distributors, together with each of their officers, and managers (collectively "Releasees"), from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage that results from my activities on the Resort premises, including all liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE of Releasees, or any other person or cause; and

Memorandum

TO: All Advisors, Chaperones, Parents and Students
FROM: Jiminy Peak Snowsports School
DATE: 9/7/12
RE: After-School Skiing/Snowboard Programs

The winter season is about to begin. As we prepare for another year of sliding, here is a friendly reminder addressing common reoccurring situations with participants. This should help lessons run smoothly and maximize the fun and learning:

1) PROPER ATTIRE:

Skiing/Snowboarding is a winter sport; all students are required to wear appropriate winter clothing as a matter of safety and comfort. Temperatures drop quickly at night so dress in layers and be prepared for the worst.

- A) Snow pants and snow jackets are required
- B) Warm hats and waterproof gloves/mittens are required
- C) If helmets are mandated by school policy, they must be worn. Helmets should fit the head semi-snugly (not loose-fitting) with the chin strap securely fastened. Helmet use is always encouraged by the Snowsports School.
- D) Snowboarding students are also encouraged to wear wrist guards. They are available from the Rental Shop at no additional cost.
- E) Clear goggles are recommended for night skiing.
- F) Headphones/ iPods/cell phones are not allowed during the lesson.
- G) Students should have pass/park pass. Pass should be kept in separate pocket away from other objects. (Lost passes can be replaced for \$25 or a temporary one can be issued for \$20)

We reserve the right to refuse a lesson if students are not properly dressed for the weather conditions.

2) PROPER EQUIPMENT:

Ski/Snowboard students should be properly equipped and fitted to their gear before arriving for their lesson. The more time spent resolving equipment issues (binding adjustments, boot tightening/loosening, adjusting clothing, etc.) at the meeting area the less time students have with instructors. If your student is renting equipment, our rental staff will assist in fitting. It is the student's responsibility to keep track of and use equipment that has been assigned and fitted to them.

- A) Boots should be tied/ buckled snugly to provide sufficient ankle support while only wearing one pair of socks.
- B) Boot should be fitted to the Ski/Snowboard binding setup properly.
- C) Snowboard bindings should be set up to the riders' preference (i.e. stance width, angle, regular vs. goofy).
- D) All ski poles must have baskets.
- E) All skis and snowboards must have metal edges.
- F) All skis must have runaway straps or ski brakes and a yearly binding release check.
- G) All snowboards must have runaway straps ("Leashes"). They are available for purchase at Mountain Sports.

3) PROPER ARRIVAL TIMES:

Students are required to arrive for their lessons 10 minutes prior to their assigned lesson times. If your student is renting equipment, it is highly recommended that they allow 30 minutes for the purpose of getting through rentals and arrive at their meeting spot 10 minutes prior to their lesson time.

- A) During the first week, students are placed in their appropriate level.
- B) It is helpful to know what trail they ski/ride on. All beginners will be placed in the Red level where they will learn the basics of the sport.
- C) Students should remember their instructor's name and their meeting place. Not all lessons meet in the same spot. Meeting spots are located outside of JJ's lodge, just off the patio (Red level) and at the top of the Cricket (Yellow, Green, and Blue/Black levels) with corresponding signs at each location. All meeting spots are the same as last season.
- D) Students that have missed the first week will be merged into existing groups at the beginning of the next lesson.
- E) Students that miss lessons may be moved to another group due to the weekly progression of their group.
- F) Students may be moved to another group for better skill matching at the discretion of the instructor.

4) PROPER BEHAVIOR:

Lessons are considered an extension of the school environment and are subject to the same standards held in school. We have fun on the mountain but must maintain order for the safety of everyone.

- A) Disruptive or disrespectful behavior between students or toward the instructor are not allowed.
- B) Horseplay (including snowball fights) at the meeting place or in a lesson is not allowed.
- C) Students must follow all safety guidelines in the responsibility code and any additional rules during their lesson.
- D) Stay with the group. Students should remain attentive and in attendance until their lesson is over.

If students do not comply with these conditions an advisor will be notified and disciplinary action may be taken.

Safety, fun and learning are our primary goals here at Jiminy Peak. Providing your students with a positive learning environment is important to us, and we thank you for your cooperation. We look forward to seeing you and your students this upcoming season.
