JOB OPENINGS

The Village is accepting applications and resumes for the position of <u>Village Clerk</u>. Applications and resumes must be submitted to the Village Office by 4:00 p.m. Monday July 21, 2014. The position has overall responsibility for the daily operations of the Village; the Clerk is also the Liaison between the Village Board and the Department Heads, is the Human Resource Officer, Village Records Officer, Registrar, Election Officer and works with the Village's Attorney, Court and Engineers as needed. The Applicant must have a valid NYS Drivers License, good interpersonal skills, computer literate, able to communicate with the residents, employees and the Village Board and Department Heads.

The Village of Menands is accepting applications for the position of <u>Part Time Building Inspector</u>. All candidates must submit a resume and completed job application to the Village Office by July 21, 2014.

The Village Building Inspector assists the Village Code Enforcement Officer with all aspects of the administration and enforcement of the NYS Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code as adopted by the Village of Menands.

Minimum and Preferred Qualifications:

- 1. High School diploma and two years of college (preferred).
- 2. Completion of NYS Basic Training requirements for code enforcement officers within two years of appointment.
- 3. Compliance with NYS continuing education requirement of additional training of 24 hours per year.
- 4. Good written and oral communication skills.
- 5. Be in good physical condition.

Primary Job Duties:

- 1. Reviews all applications for Building Permits, Certificates of Occupancy and Operating Permits.
- 2. Assists the CEO with issuance of such permits and assists with any interpretation of the Code as is necessary, pursuant to Article 189 of the NYS Executive Law.
- 3. Conducts construction inspections, inspections to be made prior to the issuance of Certificates of Occupancy and Occupancy Permits.
- 4. Conducts property maintenance inspections pursuant to the NYS Property Maintenance Law as adopted by the Village of Menands.

Applications are available in the Village Office, 250 Broadway, Menands. The Office is open from 8 A.M. until 4 P.M. Monday through Friday.
