Mulched leaves and grass should be bagged. Branches, limbs, etc. should be cut in 3 ft. lengths. We do NOT accept any dirt in the biodegradable bags. Please remember that it takes DPW approximately two weeks to go thru the Village depending on the amount of leaves at the side of the road.
