# VILLAGE OF MENANDS PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to the Village Law, the Preliminary Budget of the Village of Menands for the fiscal year beginning June 1, 2019 and ending May 31, 2020 has been duly filed.

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a tentative date for a public hearing pending approval by the Village Board on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 will be held on the second floor of the Menands Village Broadway Hall. 250 in the said Village on Thursday the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 at 6:00 P.M. by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Menands to consider the Preliminary Budget, at which time and place the comments and suggestions of residents of the Village relative to such budget to be enacted will be received.

The Preliminary Budget is on file in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer and may be inspected during office hours.

The maximum compensation to be paid to the Mayor is \$14,624.00 and each of the four trustees, \$8,530.00

# **DUMPSTER RESERVATIONS BEGIN APRIL 1ST**

Beginning April 1<sup>st</sup> - there will be a \$75.00 charge for the dumpster. To make a reservation for the dumpster, you need to come to the Village Office (8 a.m. - 4 p.m.), we can not take calls for reservations. Payment of \$75.00 will be due at time of making your reservation - No contractor's debris will be accepted. The Village crew will leave the dumpster at the end of your driveway on a Wednesday and pick it up the following Wednesday. Mark your calendar for March 29 to stop in the Village Office to schedule the dumpster starting April 1<sup>st</sup>.

# PARK RENTAL

Park reservations began March 1, at 8:00 a.m. for the 2019 season, which runs from April 15<sup>th</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> (weather permitting.) \$100 deposit and you must have a certificate of insurance from your homeowners or Renter's insurance. The park permit will not be issued until both deposit and certificate of insurance are received.

**MAYORS MESSAGE** 

I would like to say thank you for the positive feedback on the End of the Year Review. It is well worth the time it takes to put together to keep everyone informed. Since the Year End Review was completed, we have received additional positive news regarding Village finances. The Office of the State Comptroller uses the Fiscal Stress Monitoring System to examine the annual financial information reported by local governments. This analysis provides an objective assessment of the fiscal challenges facing individual local governments and school districts, identifying situations where corrective action may be needed. Based on information as of February 28, 2019, the review of the 2018 Annual Update Document (AUD) for the Village of Menands was completed. The Point Range (Out of 100 total pts) is broken down as follows:

Significant Fiscal Stress 65-100, Moderate Fiscal Stress 55-64.9, Susceptible Fiscal Stress 45-54.9, No Designation. 0-44.9. The Village of Menands received a score of 6.7 for the 2018 AUD, with no designation of fiscal stress. The report also included 2016 and 2017, both of which also were listed as no designation. Great news for Menands. As always, I am grateful for the dedication of the Village Board in providing for our departments and residents while maintaining a fiscally responsible budget and to our employees for their hard work in providing the services that are unique to Menands. #### <u>KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION</u> Menands School Kindergarten Registration for the 2019-2020 School Year

The Menands School District has begun the process of registering students for the 2019-2020 Kindergarten Class. If **you, or someone you know, has a child who will be 5 years of age on or before December 1, 2019** please contact the district registrar at **518-465-4561 ext. 100.** Registration paperwork can be printed from the school's web page (www.menands.org) or picked up in person anytime Monday through Friday from 8-4. New York State Public Health Law, Section 2164, requires certain immunizations to enter kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure your child has all the needed immunizations. A copy of your child's immunization record and his/her current physical must be submitted prior to the first day of school in order to attend kindergarten.
