Village of Menands Electrical Construction Information Sheet

- 1. All <u>Building Permit Applications</u> submitted for work that is to include electrical work must be accompanied by an <u>Electrical Permit Supplemental Application</u>.
- 2. All information on the <u>Electrical Permit Application</u> is to be completed as requested. Information may be typed or handwritten in ink.
- 3. A building permit is required to make electrical modifications unless otherwise excused in Section 1203.3 of the New York State Uniform Code or in Section 71-4B of the Menands Uniform Construction Code.
- 4. Electrical plans (i.e. power and lighting plans) must be included as part of the detailed design drawings submitted with the <u>Building Permit Application</u> or included separately with this supplemental application. Product specifications for any equipment to be included as part of the electrical work must also be included.
- 5. The Village reserves the right to mandate electrical work be performed by a NYS licensed electrician, dependent on the scope of work.
- 6. No work may commence without issuance of an approved building permit.
- 7. Any work authorized by a building permit must be available for inspection throughout the progress of the work.
- 8. All work must pass Village mandated rough-in and final inspections to be conducted by the Village and/or an approved third-party electrician. The Contractor or Property Owner is to coordinate inspections with the Village and/or an approved third-party electrician. A list of approved third-party electricians is presented on the <u>Electrical Permit Supplemental Application</u>.
