Village of Menands Plumbing Construction Information Sheet

- 1. All <u>Building Permit Applications</u> submitted for work that is to include plumbing work must be accompanied by a <u>Plumbing Permit Supplemental Application</u>.
- 2. All information on the <u>Plumbing Permit Supplemental Application</u> is to be completed as requested. Information may be typed or handwritten in ink.
- 3. A building permit is required to make plumbing modifications unless otherwise excused in Section 1203.3 of the New York State Uniform Code or in Section 71-4B of the Menands Uniform Construction Code.
- 4. Plumbing plans must be included as part of the detailed design drawings submitted with the <u>Building Permit Application</u>, or included separately with this supplemental application.
- 5. Design drawings are not required if the scope of work includes only work related to the renovation of specific plumbing apparatus.
- 6. No work may commence without issuance of an approved building permit.
- 7. Any work authorized by a building permit must be available for inspection throughout the progress of the work.
- 8. All work must pass Village mandated rough-in and final inspections. The Contractor or Property Owner is to coordinate inspections with the Village.
