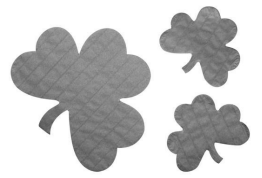

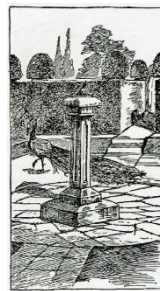
FREE LEARNING OPPORTUNITY

SOLVING A MYSTERY

As most people know, the Sage name has long been affiliated with Menands history. Mr. Dean Sage was the first member of the Sage family to purchase land on the north side of the old Menand Road in the mid 19th Century where he established his fine estate called "Hillside". Mrs. Dean Sage continued to reside there after her husband Dean had passed away and at some point in the very early 20th Century caused a duplicate to



be made of a bronze sundial on a pedestal, a replica of one on the estate of Sr. Walter Scott in the United Kingdom. The sundial was shipped to Mrs. Dean Sage at "Hillside" in Menands. Of course the last Sage to reside in Menands was Mrs. Henry Sage, the 2nd wife of Senator Henry Sage of the more commonly known "Sage Estate" on the south side of the Menand

Road. The British Sundial Society is seeking to locate the whereabouts of the duplicate sundial that made its way to the "Hillside" estate of Mrs. Dean Sage so that they may have the bronze sundial itself carefully measured and photographed so they can have a reproduction made of it to replace the original one stolen from atop of the pedestal in the estate of Sr. Walter Scott.
