IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Village of Menands office reopened to the public May 26, 2020 with the regular hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (The Village Court remains closed until further notice). SPECIAL PICK-UP

Special Pick-up will resume on Wednesday's only. (If a holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, there will be NO special pick-up that week). For special pick-up, you must call the Village Office at (434-2922) by Tuesday before 4 p.m. to be added to the Wednesday schedule. This is a homeowner service for household items larger than normal trash and NOT to be used by contractors doing work at Village residences. PROHIBITED ITEMS include: Televisions, Cans containing Wet Paint (air dry before disposal), Computer Monitors, Medical Waste, Propane Tanks, Contractor's materials (contractor responsible for disposal), and Tires. It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of these items themselves and not leave curbside. The DPW will NOT pick up these items. Leaf and yard waste should be put in bags at the curbside.

UPCOMING VOTING INFORMATION

With coronavirus and quarantine, New York State has expanded the guidelines for absentee voting for upcoming elections. For people nervous about going to the voting polls, this will allow them to participate in elections from their home.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, on April 24, 2020 Governor Cuomo signed an executive order (EO 202.23) requiring local boards of elections to mail an absentee ballot application with a postage paid return envelope to voters eligible to vote in the June 23rd primary election. (In NYS in order to vote in a Primary you must be enrolled in the party having the Primary. There may not always be a Primary for your party enrollment). Registered voters should have received a yellow postcard with information, including polling place, should they choose to vote in person. (Reminder: Menands School is no longer a polling place)

Additionally, the Menands UFSD budget vote and Board of Education elections to be held on June 9, 2020 will be by **absentee ballot only**. All qualified voters of the Menands UFSD will be sent an absentee ballot together with a postage paid return envelope. A white postcard was mailed from Menands UFSD with voting information. MENANDS BIKE-PEDESTRIAN CONNECTOR PROJECT UPDATE

We are planning to close the North Bound On Ramp from the Menands Connector (Exit 6) to North Bound I-787, the ramp will be closed from Tuesday, May 26, 2020 through Thursday June 25, 2020. During this closure, traffic that needs to go NB from Menands via I-787 will be detoured North on Route 32 to Route 378 East, once on Route 378 East they can access North Bound I-787 via the exit 7 NB on ramp. Access to South Bound I-787 from the Menands Connector (Exit 6) will remain open during this time.
