All information is confidential and can not be used against you in any way. Your landlord can not view any information you provide to the Census, but you need to count everyone living with you. Law enforcement can not come after you from filling out the Census.

Leaders from all parts of our community are in support of the required counting of every member of your household, including the Menands School Superintendent, The Menands School PTA President, the Village of Menands Mayor, our Albany County Legislator, and our NY State Assemblymember.
