MARILYN MCGOVERN'S BEAN STEW

1 LB BACON

1 LB HAMBURGER (optional)

1 LARGE ONION

1 C BROWN SUGAR

1 C KETCHUP

1 TSP LIQUID SMOKE

2 CANS PORK & BEANS

1 CAN KIDNEY BEANS

1 CAN BUTTER BEANS, rinsed

SALT & PEPPER TO TASTE

Fry bacon until crisp and drain. Brown hamburger (if using) and onion. Put in Crock Pot with remaining ingredients and mix. Cook on low for 2 to 2 ½ hours. The hamburger may be eliminated and green pepper may be added. (I don't use either).

A double recipe will fill a 9x12 pan and a small bowl and may be placed in the oven for an hour or two at 350 degrees. Longer cooking will not hurt and may be desirable.
