RECIPES

CHEESY POTATOES

5 LBS Red Potatoes

1 lb Velvetta Cheese

Jar or Real Bacon Bits

1/3 jar of Mayonaise

Cook potatoes until you can poke with fork. When cool cube potatoes, cube velveeta cheese, sprinkle with bacon. Mix with mayonnaise, put in 9X13" pan. Bake at 350 for approximately 45 minutes or until cheese melts

FROG'S EYE SALAD

(Italian Fruit Salad)

1C Uncooked Pepicini #27 macaroni or Acini DiPepe #44

2 20oz cans crushed pineapple

1 15oz can mandarin oranges

1C sugar

2T flour or corn starch

2 eggs

1 8oz cool whip

Drain fruit into Dutch oven and save juice.

Cook macaroni according to directions.

Add sugar, flour, eggs and mix.

Cook until thickened stirring constantly, remove from heat

Add cooked macaroni and fruit mixture, chill overnight in Dutch oven.

Before serving add Cool Whip.
