VILLAGE OFFICE IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Village of Menands Clerk's Office reopened to the public April 5, 2021, with the regular office hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Social distancing guidelines will be in place to protect the safety of our staff and the public. Masks must be worn before entering the building. In order to adhere to the 6ft. social distancing guidelines, only two members of the public will be allowed in the office at the same time. Only office personnel will be allowed access past the front counter. The dropbox will remain in the vestibule, for those not wanting to enter the office, which is available during office hours. After hours, the public may drop items off in the mail slot next to the main entrance. We ask that any matters that can be handled over the phone, please call the Village office at 518-434-2922 for assistance, instead of appearing in person. All public meetings will continue virtually until further notice. We thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate through these difficult times.

VILLAGE OF MENANDS ELECTION

The General Election for the Village of Menands will be held on **Tuesday**, **June 15**, **2021** between the hours of 12 noon and 9:00 P.M. at which time the Village Justice and two Trustees are to be elected for a four-year term to commence pursuant to law upon their qualifications and no earlier than July 5th, 2021. Absentee ballot applications are available at the Village Office and on the Website. Absentee Ballot applications are to be returned to Menands Village Office. You can postmark, email or fax a completed application or letter request for the Village Election Absentee ballot no later than 7 days (June 9, 2021) before the election.

(Please be aware that despite the above deadlines, the Post Office has advised that they cannot guarantee timely delivery of ballots applied for LESS THAN 15 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION.)

PARK RESERVATIONS

To reserve the Park between May 1, 2021 and October 31, 2021 (weather permitting please contact the Village Office at (518) 434-2922 for instructions on reserving the park this year, as they may be different from other years due to the pandemic. To reserve the park, you must be a resident or business within the Village of Menands. The rental fee is \$50.00 plus \$100.00 deposit (the deposit is refundable if rules and regulations are adhered to). The \$150.00, application and a Certificate of Insurance from your Homeowners, Renters or business insurance policy (as outlined on reservation application) must be submitted to secure your reservation. Park reservations are on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations are subject to cancellation or modification in compliance with NYS guidelines, (with a full refund), to ensure public health and safety. LETTER OF THANKS

An open letter of thanks, from the other side of the tracks...It occurred to me last night, during my 2 a.m. trip to the bathroom, that I needed to thank the persons responsible for making Menands a quiet zone to the D&H railroad during the evening hours. Those of us living on the "other side of the tracks" can finally get a good night's sleep without the excessive horn from the midnight train runs. You remember that horn, the one that bolted you upright from bed at ungodly hours of the night, then you would toss and turn unable to resume your sleep, just about to finally nod off when in the distance you could feel the tremble of another ensuing quake. Generations of Menands residents relocated with PTSD from life on the tracks. Those of us with a "front row seat" (and God bless Villa Road households), grumbled for generations about the rumble of those trains. Think back to the large Menands families that grew up in this neighborhood. An unknowing traveler may rationalize they filled those large Victorian houses with enough kids to fill the rafters. But the reality may have a direct correlation to those late night train horns...think about it, what else to do to lull a tired soul back to slumber? Those of you not living on the tracks may think this a trivial matter, however, with the "quiet zone" we can finally obtain a peaceful night's sleep. Additionally, our property value has increased. You have no idea how many generations of "village people" have been traumatized by that late night horn. We believed it was a D&H engineer's sole purpose to cause as much nightly disruption as possible and we are certain they laughed at their antics at our expense. Many days/evenings trying to lull an irritable baby to sleep walking her in the stroller down Villa Road, I can recall bolting, I'm talking a full-on run, down Villa to close the gap between a baby on the cusp of sleep and an ensuing locomotive. And summertime, that time of year we all opened windows to enjoy the sweet summer air...are you insane? That's the reason many of these large Victorians have been retrofitted with air conditioners, to keep that horn out! I recall how we'd lose the entire tball team to watching those trains rather than fielding the ball or swinging the bat. But that's what made Menands, Menands. Our "urban village". It's quaint, it's caring, and finally it's quiet. Thank you.
