VILLAGE OF MENANDS ELECTION

The General Election for the Village of Menands will be held on Tuesday, June 15, 2021 between the hours of 12 noon and 9:00 P.M. at which time the Village Justice and two Trustees are to be elected for a four-year term to commence pursuant to law upon their qualifications and no earlier than July 5th, 2021. Absentee ballot applications are available at the Village Office and on the Website. Absentee Ballot applications are to be returned to Menands Village Office. You can postmark, email or fax a completed application or letter request for the Village Election Absentee ballot no later than 7 days (June 9, 2021) before the election. (Please be aware that despite the above deadlines, the Post Office has advised that they cannot guarantee timely delivery of ballots applied for LESS THAN 15 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION.)

PARK RESERVATIONS

To reserve the Park between now and October 31, 2021 (weather permitting) please contact the Village Office at (518) 434-2922 for instructions on reserving the park this year, as they may be different from other years due to the pandemic. To reserve the park, you must be a resident or business within the Village of Menands. The rental fee is \$50.00 plus \$100.00 deposit (the deposit is refundable if rules and regulations are adhered to). The \$150.00, application and a Certificate of Insurance from your Homeowners, Renters or business insurance policy (as outlined on reservation application) must be submitted to secure your reservation. Park reservations are on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations are subject to cancellation or modification in compliance with NYS guidelines, (with a full refund), to ensure public health and safety. DUMPSTER RESERVATIONS

Dumpster reservations began April 1st. There will be a charge of \$100 for the dumpster rental. To make a reservation for the dumpster, please call the Village Office Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon at 518-434-2922 or e-mail Clerk Handerhan at Handerhan@Villageofmenands.com for more information. Payment of \$100 will be due prior to the reservation date. No contractor's debris will be accepted. The Village crew will leave the dumpster at the end of your driveway on a Wednesday and pick it up the following Wednesday.

STORYWALK

The Village of Menands Board of Trustees, Menands School, Menands Public Library, and the Upper Hudson Library System are excited to announce the grand opening of our StoryWalk, to be located on the upper purple trail of the Sage Estates Trail System (about 100 feet from the Park Drive entrance, across from Mountain View). Children and families will be able to read a picture book, with pages displayed in weatherproof kiosks, while getting exercise and spending time outdoors.
