VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

The next Village Board Meeting will be held in person, on Monday, August 16, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. All meetings are held at 250 Broadway in Menands in the municipal building upstairs in the Court Room. Board meetings are open to the public and are handicap accessible.

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS

In an effort to maintain a safe level of water in our reservoirs during the summer months, and while more people are home during the day, we need the cooperation of our residents and business owners.

If you need to use water on the outside of your home or business, please do so sparingly and NOT water lawns between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. In addition, we ask that you ONLY water on the days as follows: If your street address number is an even number, only water on even days of the month, likewise, if your street address number is odd, only water on the odd days of the month.

This conservation effort will create less water usage per day, allowing the reservoir to maintain at a safe level during the summer months. This will also be beneficial to the resident and business owners that typically have a higher water consumption bill.

With everyone's cooperation, we hope a watering ban will not be necessary, as other local communities have implemented during extreme heat or drought conditions. Thank you.

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

While writing my end of the year update in May, I inadvertently excluded a report from the Village Historian. Despite the challenges of the pandemic, Historian Kevin Franklin remained busy working on various projects this past year. Kevin worked with U-Haul, (the new owners of the old Williams Press), regarding historic background of the building and information pertaining to a mural in the lobby honoring Johannes Gutenberg and his invention of movable type in the mid 1400's, which revolutionized the printing industry worldwide. This important work, painted by noted Albany area artist David Lithgow, sustained mold and water damage, but the hope was that U-Haul might restore the mural to preserve its history. Kevin also provided information and graphic ideas for the interpretive signage for the Sage Estate Trail system. Additionally, he provided information to the Soldier On project for veterans housing being developed on the many men from Menands who fought during WWII, including past Village Clerk Charles Moore, who was a recipient of bronze stars and purple heart for actions against German Soldiers. Kevin also provided historic background information on the Hudson River and lands on the west bank in Menands to be used for grant opportunities for Hudson River Estuary projects. Kevin continues to follow leads to a possible location of a duplicate sundial of Sir Walter that was once on the estate of the Dean Sage family in Menands at "Hillside". He helped with finding the deed for Ganser-Smith Park from the Albany Hall of Records. Kevin continues to answer the many calls and emails from people regarding various aspects of Village history, including doing talks and presentations to different groups. Kevin has a wealth of knowledge, and we are grateful for his dedication and willingness to research and share historic information on Menands.

<u>ePAYMENT ANNOUNCEMENT</u>

The Village of Menands has great news! You asked and we listened; As of June 1, 2021, we started offering ONLINE PAYMENTS via Xpress-pay! This includes credit cards, debit cards, and electronic check payments. There is a site processing fee of 2.95% + \$.40 for using a card and a \$1.75 site processing fee for an electronic check payment. This is a secure platform with the option to create a username and password, the ability to pay multiple accounts, whether it is for separate properties, water & sewer utility billing, or taxes. You can see the current amount due (including penalty if applicable), and it provides a receipt upon receiving payment. This system also has the option to notify you when a new bill is due via text message or email once a user profile has been created. PARK RESERVATIONS:

To reserve the Ganser-Smith Park between now and October 31, 2021 (weather permitting), please contact the Village Office at (518) 434-2922. The Park rental will not be available for the Month of September due to construction. To reserve the park, you must be a resident or business within the Village of Menands. The rental fee is \$50.00, plus a \$100.00 deposit (the deposit is refundable if rules and regulations are adhered to). The \$150.00, application and a Certificate of Insurance from your Homeowners, Renters, or business insurance policy (as outlined on the reservation application), must be submitted to secure your reservation. reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Reservations are subject to cancellation or modification in compliance with NYS guidelines (with a full re-fund), to ensure public health and safety.
