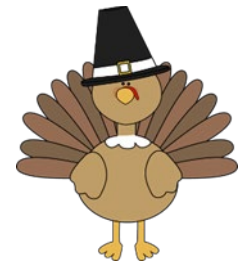

CORN CASSEROLE, by Paula Deen (worth repeating)

1 15 ¼ can whole kernel corn, drained

1 14 ¾ can cream-style corn

1 8oz. pkg. corn muffin mix (Jiffy)

1 C sour cream

½ C (1 stick) butter, melted

1 to 1 ½ C shredded cheddar cheese

Preheat oven to 350.

In large bowl, stir tog. 2 cans of corn, corn muffin mix, sour cream and melted butter.

Pour into a 9 x 13inch casserole dish.

Bake 45 min. or until golden brown.

Remove from oven and top with cheddar cheese.

Return to oven for 5-10 min. or until cheese is melted.

Let stand for at least 5 minutes and then serve warm.
