VILLAGE TAX AND WATER & SEWER BILLS

Village Tax Bills were due without penalty on June 30, 2022, and Water & Sewer Bills were due July 31, 2022. Please be aware that homeowners are responsible for all Village bills and timely payment - even if lost in the mail. If either Bill remains unpaid, please include the proper interest amount, valid through the end of the month you're paying in when issuing payment; if the envelope is not postmarked on the last day of the month or before, it will be returned for missing penalty. Unpaid Tax will be levied to Albany County on November 1st. Unpaid water & sewer bills will be applied to January's water and sewer bill.
