VILLAGE OF MENANDS ZBA PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, November 10th, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. at 250 Broadway to consider the following application for an Area Variance and Use Variance.

Daughters of Charity, 98 Menands Road, Area & Use Variance.

Daughters of Charity, 98 Menands Road is in an "R" Zone, Chapter 169 Schedule "A" does not list the proposed development as a "Principal Use Permitted by Right" or a "Use Permitted by Special Permit", therefore, it is not allowed in an "R" Zone. Also, Chapter 169 Schedule "B" states in an "R" Zone the maximum building height is 35' and the number of stories is 2 ½, the primary building height is 79'and exceeds 2 ½ stories tall.

Such Public Hearings are open to the public and are handicap accessible. LEAF COLLECTION

The DPW has begun to pick up leaves that are raked onto the edge of the road/street (the leaf machine cannot pick up leaves that are not on the street). When placing your leaves on the street, DO NOT block or place your leaves in the storm drain. Please remember that it takes the DPW roughly 2 weeks to go through the Village, depending on the amount of leaves on the side of the road.

NOTE: Mulched leaves and grass should be bagged. We do NOT accept any dirt in biodegradable bags. Branches, limbs, etc., should be cut into 3ft lengths. If a contractor/landscaper is hired for leaf pick up, they must remove the leaves with them. The leaf machine pick up will end before the first plowable snowfall.
