RESIDENTIAL WATER CUSTOMERS: MANDATORY NOTICE

As you may know, The Village of Menands has contracted with East National Water, LLC., to install water meters with radios compatible with the Village's current water meter reading equipment. This new equipment will be installed at no cost to you, the customer. THIS PROCESS IS MANDATORY, and we request a one-hour window of time to schedule the appointment at your property.

Please call East National Water, LLC at their toll-free number 1-800-252-8556 or 833-488-4580 to schedule an appointment to install your meter. The office is staffed from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM for scheduling; if you call outside of these hours, you may leave a message and your call will be returned. You may also schedule online anytime at: http://eastnationalwater.com/schedule/ by using the Menands appointment link. Please use your 5digit number code located on the bottom left of the mailing label on the green card to schedule. If you have not received a card from East National, if your card has been lost or discarded, OR if you would like assistance scheduling, please contact Nicole from the 518-434-2922. PARK RESERVATIONS

To reserve the Park between July 1, 2022, and October 31, 2022 (weather permitting), please contact the Village Office at (518) 434-2922 for instructions on reserving the park. To reserve the park, you must be a resident or business within the Village of Menands. The rental fee is \$50.00 plus \$100.00 deposit (the deposit is refundable if rules and regulations are adhered to). The \$150.00, application and a Certificate of Insurance from your Homeowners, Renters, or business insurance policy (as outlined on reservation application) must be submitted to secure your reservation. Park reservations are on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations are subject to cancellation or modification in compliance with NYS guidelines, (with a full refund), to ensure public health and safety. VILLAGE OF MENANDS ZBA PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held on **Thursday, August 4, 2022, at 6:00 P.M.** at 250 Broadway to consider the following application for an Area Variance and a Use Variance.

- 1. Daughters of Charity, 98 Menands Road, Area & Use Variance
- 2. Joe Vellano, Daycare Business, 31 North Lyons Avenue, Use Variance
- 3. 5 Elmwood Road, Warehousing with Wholesale and Distribution, Use Variance

Daughters of Charity, 98 Menand Road is in an "R" Zone. Chapter 169 Schedule "A" does not list this proposed development as a "Principal Use Permitted by Right" or a "Use Permitted by Special Permit", therefore, it is not allowed in an "R" Zone. Also, Chapter 169 Schedule "B" states in an "R" Zone the maximum building height is 35' and the number of stories is 2 ½; the primary building height is 79' and exceeds 2½ stories tall.

Joe Vellano, Daycare Business, 31 North Lyons Avenue based in Chapter 169, Schedule "A" in the Village of Menands and Zone "R-1" is not a Principal Use permitted by Right or a Use Permitted by Special Permit, therefore, the Daycare Business can not be in the "R-1" Zone.

Andy Brick, 5 Elmwood Road based on the information provided in the submitted building permit application stating the potential use of the property located at 5 Elmwood Road of "Warehousing with wholesalers and

Elmwood Road of "Warehousing with wholesalers and distribution' is not a principal use permitted by right or a use permitted by special permit in the T-4 Zone.
