STATE URGES RESIDENTS TO BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR SPOTTED LANTERNFLY

The New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets continues to urge New Yorkers to be on the lookout for Spotted Lanternfly (SLF). SLF is a destructive pest that threatens the agriculture and forest industries by feeding on more than 70 plant species, including tree-of-heaven, and plants and crops that are critical to New York's agricultural economy, such as

grapevine, apple trees, and hops. It is also a nuisance pest. In New York, SLF has been found on Staten Island, all New York City boroughs, Long Island, Port Jervis, Sloatsburg, Orangeburg, Ithaca, Binghamton, Middletown, Newburgh, Highland, and the Buffalo area. Since January 2018, the Department has been working cooperatively with multiple state and federal partners to monitor SLF populations in New York. Regulatory actions have also been put in place to mitigate the risk of SLF arriving in New York. Outreach to the public, trade groups, and other stakeholders are ongoing to provide upto-date information related to SLF.

We need your help to ensure that SLF does not come to Menands! Check out photos of SLF at different life stages at https://agriculture.ny.gov/plant-industry/have-you-seen-spotted-lanternfly. From July through December, be on the lookout for adults (pictured here). During the winter season, you can also be on the lookout for egg masses. Egg masses can be found on trees, cars, and any outdoor equipment and if any are found, the Department encourages residents to scrape and destroy them. A good resource is this video. Report any sightings of SLF immediately. Follow these steps:

- Take a photo
- Collect a sample and place it in a freezer or in a jar with rubbing alcohol or hand sanitizer
- Contact the SLF responders

After you have reported SLF in your area and collected a sample, you should kill any additional SLF you see by stepping on it or crushing it. Learn more: ttps://agriculture.ny.gov/spottedlanternfly.
