Village Tax Bills were due without penalty on June 30, 2023, and Water & Sewer Bills are due on July 31, 2023. Please be aware that homeowners are responsible for all Village bills and timely payment - even if lost in the mail. If either Bill remains unpaid, please include the proper interest amount found in the penalty table located on the bill, valid through the end of the month you are paying in when issuing payment; if the envelope is not postmarked on the last day of the month or before, it will be returned for missing penalty. <u>DPW REMINDERS - SECURING & STORING</u> <u>GARBAGE CONTAINERS</u>

- A. Residents shall be required to recover and secure emptied garbage containers and/or other waste receptacles from curbside by 7:00 p.m. on the day of the scheduled refuse collection.
- B. Garbage containers must be stored in a location on the premises of the primary occupant or resident (i.e., garage, shed, porch), that is generally out of sight of adjoining property owners and the public. Garbage containers may not be left on the side of the premises that face a public street or right-of-way.
- C. A person(s) found offending or violating this section after written complaint shall be guilty of a violation subject to penalties, including fines.

GARBAGE CONTAINER REQUIREMENTS

Garbage placed outside for collection must be tied in clear or white (opaque) plastic garbage bags and placed in a conforming garbage container. No single garbage container placed for collection shall exceed 40 pounds. Persons not placing garbage in a sealed garbage container may be found in violation if the garbage bags are untied or broken and the contents are strewn, or if an unsealed garbage container weighs more than 40 pounds, including infiltration by water. Person(s) found offending or violating this section after a written complaint shall be guilty of a violation subject to the penalties, including fines, under § 82-10 of this article. You may have multiple garbage containers, best practice to stay under the weight limit is not to exceed a 64-gallon trash can.
