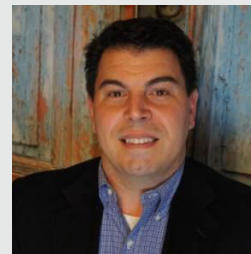

MAYOR'S CORNER

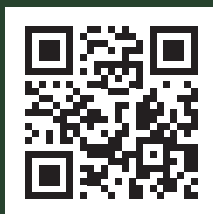

MAILWORKS

Mailworks, a company that relocated to Menands in 2024, is situated at 236 Broadway. They specialize in High Volume Mailings and Expert Marketing Services. In a typical week, Mailworks sends out 2,704,571 pieces of mail, processes 3,405 proofs, handles 34 product types, collaborates with 141 companies, and delivers to 1,606 locations. **Currently, Mailworks is in the process of acquiring 5 Elmwood Road, the former "Olympic Lanes", which will allow them to expand their presence in the Village of Menands. On Monday, October 6, 2025, during the Village Board of Trustees meeting, Mailworks was granted a Special Use Permit. This decision will help advance the project. Mailworks intends to utilize the building to boost production, which will enable them to increase their workforce by 50 employees.**

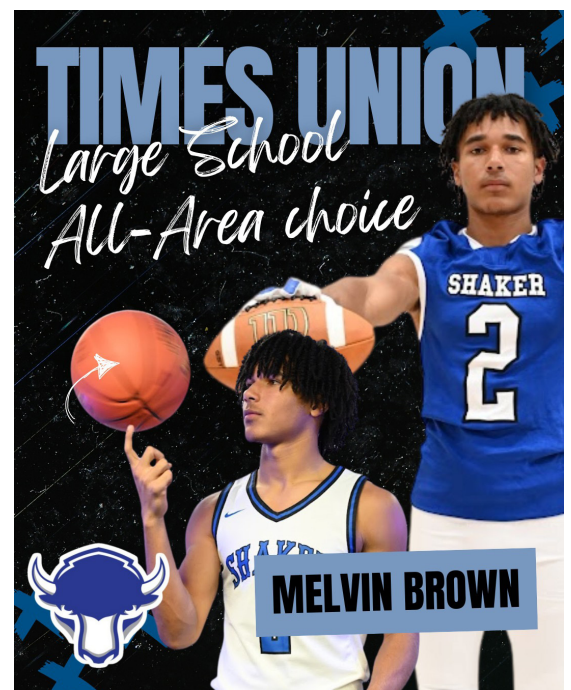

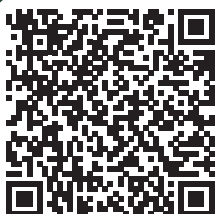
CONGRATULATIONS TO MELVIN BROWN!
